## WALK FOR INDIA



India is in crisis and needs our help.

This June marks 20 years since we lost our lovely son & brother, Seb, and set up our charity helping vulnerable communities in India. To mark Seb's life

and the remarkable achievements of the charity, and to support India at a time of critical need, we'd love you to join us on **Sunday 6<sup>th</sup> June** to Walk for India. We have a few options so that everyone can be involved.

### Option 1

Laura and Adam will be setting off from Fortune House at 8am and walking the 40km to Shoreham. This will be an all-day walk and everyone will need to bring a packed lunch and drinks. We estimate the walk to take around 8 hours and we will confirm plans to get back to Fortune House at the end once we know numbers. Details of this walk and route are attached.

### Option 2

Anna and Graham will be setting off from Ewhurst at 10am and walking 5 miles in a circular route.

### Option 3

Design your own walk wherever you are in the world and whatever day works best for you. Set up a fundraising page and think of Seb, and all these in need in India.

## Where will funds go?

Our schools have had to close because of the devastating extent of the pandemic in towns and villages. We normally provide a lunchtime main meal for the children when at school, so now, with our teachers and health workers, Seb's Projects are providing and delivering provisions for the children and their families.

The main hospital in the area around Vellore, Christian Medical College, is besieged with covid patients and their distressed families. There are not enough medical supplies. Our staff are providing some food and drinks and what help they can to these people and the homeless.

Funds received go straight to those in need - there are no overheads or deductions.

### Any funds raised from this walk will go towards two main areas:

**Relief Work** in terms of provision to our tribal school children and their families. We would like to provide a food bag to each family. The Jawadhi hills where we work are quite remote and isolated.

The only way they could get infected is a visit to the market in the plains. We would like to discourage such trips. We are targeting about 350 families and the cost of a Food Bag for a month is about 1000 rupees (£10 per family).

**Medical Support** This is a desperate need of this hour. Doctors from the Christian Medical College and Hospital, Vellore are overwhelmed with the cases in the hospital and are planning a Home care program. This is where patients who are not severely ill could get the right advice and a medical kit, and also provide oxygen concentrators if need be. They are working on the logistics of this massive initiative and need help with funding.
