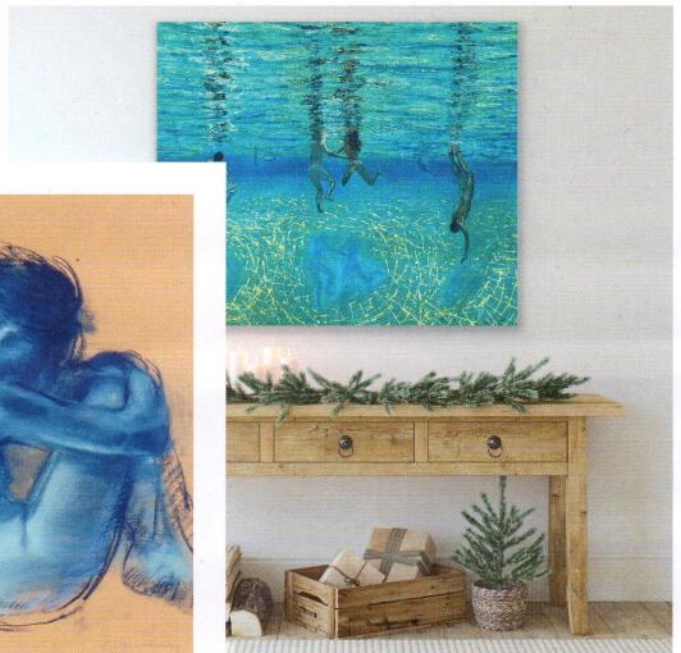


BELGRAVIA GALLERY
